The Cottage Supervisor is responsible for oversight of the residential cottage. The primary responsibilities include but are not limited to: Personnel (procurement/staffing), Physical Plant (environment of care) and Therapeutic Environment Management of the residential program in collaboration with the Clinician. In addition, the CS is responsible for the ongoing supervision of all Treatment Counselors/Direct Care Staff.

Education/Experience: In accordance with State of Alaska residential care licensing regulation and medicaid the Cottage Supervisor must be at least twenty-one years of age, have a valid driver's license and have an Associate's Degree, preferably with major study in psychology, sociology, social work, social sciences or a closely related field and two years' experience in the supervision and management of a residential facility for care and treatment of children. Six years' experience serving children in a residential setting may be substituted for the associate's degree.
